

Race Disqualifications

Actions during a race that are a disqualification. Driver will be black flagged and must exit track.

- A. Flagrant or Deliberate Rough Driving (a driver that is intentionally running over or into the car in front or behind)
- B. All four wheels below the yellow line and continues past the next corner.
- C. Disobeying flags
- D. Handlers signaling to drivers under green flag conditions
- E. Car being operating in an unsafe manner (excessive biking, stuck throttle, no brakes, etc.)
- F. Making adjustments or repairs on the track
- G. Driver receives three strikes, DNF (rookies will stay on track unless unsafe)
- H. Improper wearing of neck collar, belts not over both shoulders, helmet not fastened
- I. Loss of safety equipment under green flag conditions; helmet, gloves, arm restraints, belts. (not neck collar)
- J. Loss of fluid on the track that is deemed unsafe
- K. Loss of ballast during a race (yellow or green)
- L. Leaves the racing surface under green flag, DNF cannot re-enter race
